

U.S. Commission Program Eligibility Chart

Effective Monday, July 6, 2009, the upfront commission on BD published fares may only be taken on tickets issued using through-fares from the U.S. to Eastern Europe, the Middle East, Africa and Asia. Travel must use BD* codeshare flights for the transatlantic sectors, and flights BD0001 – BD1999 for all other sectors.

Routes/fares that are eligible for upfront commission:

Through-fares from the U.S. to the Middle East

Current BD destinations: Cairo, Tehran, Tel Aviv, Amman, Beirut, Dammam, Jeddah, Riyadh, Khartoum, Aleppo, Damascus

Through-fares from the U.S. to Eastern Europe & Central Asia

Current BD destinations: Yerevan, Baku, Tbilisi, Almaty, Bishkek, Moscow, Kiev

Through-fares from the U.S. to Africa

Current BD destinations: Addis Ababa, Freetown

Routes/fares that are not eligible for upfront commission:

Through-fares from the U.S. to Western Europe (including the U.K.)

Current BD destinations: Aberdeen, Belfast, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Manchester, Amsterdam, Brussels, Dublin, Hanover, Palma, Venice

All end-on-end constructed fares from the U.S. over London (where the fare is broken at London), including any journeys where connections are to another codeshare partner.

Relevant BD destinations: All those listed previously

Example BD* destinations: Abu Dhabi, Bahrain, Berlin, Doha, Milan, Stockholm

All fares on BD services that have not been booked in conjunction with a transatlantic codeshare service (i.e. "offline sales").

Examples: All BD services from London; all bmi Regional services (including Manchester-Aberdeen, Edinburgh-Copenhagen etc.)

All fares on BD* codeshare journeys that have not been booked in conjunction with a BD operated service.

bmi has codeshare agreements with United Airlines, Virgin Atlantic, Air New Zealand and US Airways on flights from the U.S. connecting through London Heathrow.
